

## **Summer Germany 2010 Scholarship: “Share Your World”**

**Overview:** The purpose of this scholarship is to award one resourceful and dedicated student who is able to share his study abroad experiences through winsome and creative presentations at their high school or in their community. The winner will be awarded \$1000 and is required to speak to peers about their experiences before and after the month-long program in Berlin. This scholarship is open to all 2010 Summer Germany applicants. The winner will also be asked for a high resolution digital image of themselves for our website.

### **Presentation rules and guidelines:**

1. Prepare and give two presentations to a group of your peers. The first presentation is to be given before you go abroad. The second presentation should be given within 3 months of returning from Germany.
2. Group size: minimum 15 people.
3. Confirmation of presentations: An adult (teacher or community representative) must sign a form confirming the time, date, location and number of people present.
4. Your first presentation will speak to your motivation, preparation, goals and expectations for studying abroad. In essence, why you want to go to Germany and what you expect to gain from the experience.
5. Your second presentation will be based upon your study abroad and host family experiences while in Berlin. Speak about the goals you reached, any challenges you faced and how you overcame them, discoveries about yourself and Germany, anecdotes about living in a foreign land, learning and speaking German, and how studying abroad has and will impact your life.

### **How to apply:**

- **Submit a proposal for your two presentations in outline form. Provide a summary of how and to whom you plan on making your presentations.**

**Application Deadline:** March 31, 2010

**Program Dates:** June 28<sup>th</sup> – August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009

**Award:** \$1000 scholarship. \$500 will be awarded after each presentation.

**Eligibility:** You must successfully complete the Summer Germany 2010 program.

*If you are not awarded a scholarship and elect to withdraw your program application Intrax Study Abroad cancellation penalties will apply.*

**Length:** 3 page maximum
