

Global Citizen Scholarship Overview

Overview: The purpose of this scholarship is to award \$2000 to 7 resourceful and mature students who are passionate about international exchange, bettering their community and self-growth. This scholarship is for Intrax Study Abroad students who will be participating on a 2010-2011 Academic Year, 2010 Fall Semester, or 2010 Fall Trimester program in Australia, Ecuador, France, Germany, The Netherlands, Ireland, Japan, or Spain.

Requirements: Winners of the Global Citizen scholarship must:

- Successfully complete their Study Abroad Program.
- During their Study Abroad Program, participate in at least 10 hours of community service within their host community.
- Within 3 months of the end of their Study Abroad Program,
 - Submit a Photo Essay of at least 25 high-quality digital photographs and captions. The Photo Essay must document their host community, community service and overall exchange experience.
 - Give a presentation about their study abroad experience to at least 50 high school students. The high school's principal, guidance counselor, or a foreign language teacher, or an AYUSA Field Staff Representative, must attend the presentation and sign a Proof of Presentation form. The winner must then submit this form to Intrax.

Scholarship Timeline:

- **Scholarship Application Deadline: March 1, 2010**
- **Program Application Deadline: March 31, 2010** Students who have not submitted their COMPLETE program application (including the [online application](#) AND any additional paperwork) by March 31 will not be considered for the scholarship.
- **Winners will be notified by:** April 30, 2010
- ***If you are not selected to receive a scholarship award and elect to cancel your program application, normal Intrax Study Abroad cancellation penalties will apply.***
- **Distribution of Funds:** The scholarship will be dispersed in 2 payments:
 - Upon selection, winners will automatically receive \$1000 directly applied to the cost of their program.
 - Winners will receive a check for the remaining \$1000 after we have received their Proof of Presentation Form and Photo Essay.
