

## Spain Teaching Scholarship Application

**Overview:** The purpose of this scholarship is to award 500 – 1500 Euros to 8 resourceful and mature students who are passionate about international exchange, bettering their community and self-growth. This scholarship is for AYUSA Study Abroad students who will be participating on a 2011-2012 Academic Year, 2011 Spring Semester, 2011 Fall Semester, or 2011 Fall Trimester program in Spain.

**Requirements:** Recipients of the Spain Teaching Scholarship:

- Submit a 300 – 500 word essay explaining why you should be considered for the Teaching Scholarship.
- Successfully complete their Study Abroad Program.
- During their Study Abroad Program, recipients agree to offer a minimum of 5 hours per week of English conversation to their Spanish host family and or siblings.
- Recipients who do not keep this agreement will forfeit all subsequent scholarship payments.

**Scholarship Payments:** Recipients of the Spain Teaching Scholarship:

- 2200Euros for Academic Year participants (4 awards)
- 800Euros for Fall Semester participants (2 awards)
- 500Euros for Fall Trimester participants (2 awards)
- 500Euros for Spring Semester participants (2 awards)
- Scholarship amounts are paid as a monthly stipend directly to the recipients while on program.

**Scholarship Timeline:**

- **Scholarship Application Deadline: March 1, 2011 for fall/academic year (September 1, 2010 for Spring 2011 program)**
- **Program Application Deadline: March 31, 2011 for summer/fall/academic year (September 30, 2010 for Spring 2011 program)** Students who have not submitted their COMPLETE program application (including the [online application](#) AND any additional paperwork) by March 31 (September 30, 2010 for Spring program) will not be considered for the scholarship.
- **Recipients will be notified by:** April 30, 2011 for fall and academic year programs (October 31, 2010 for Spring 2011 programs)
- *If you are not selected for this scholarship and you withdraw your program application normal cancellation penalties apply.*
